1. Review of the CLC strategy

Simon went through changes he had drafted into the strategy document:

- Tweak around the big industry asks;
- More focused on tangible deliverables;
- 'Challenges' and 'Priorities' slides added;
- 'Our Purpose' strapline to be looked at;
- 'Intersections' slide – narrative behind each workstream needed;
- Possibly create a quick graphic that links to specifics on the website;
- Group recognised a need to focus on the 'big-ticket' items;
- Simon agreed to consider comments further off-line and refine.

2. PMO – scope of service and funding

- Options for the future role and funding of the PMO were discussed, including contributions from CLC members

3. Deep dive into Net Zero Carbon

- Suggested ways forward:
 - Is a focus workshop necessary initially for net zero leads within the industry and CLC?
 - Identify and agree what are the top three priorities for the sector at COP 26. BEIS and PMO to take forward, with David Pinder.
 - GBC / GCB – encourage them to work together in a coordinated way and produced a plan in a matter of weeks.

4. CLC Website/HSE request to CLC to host

- Request for CONIAC to be migrated to, and hosted by, the CLC website
- Current CONIAC site software out-dated and lack of sufficient funds to update and maintain it. HSE seeking to transfer the CONIAC content on their website to the CLC website.
 - If CLC were to host the CONIAC website, it raises wider issues and risks the CLC being approached by multiple organisations requesting CLC hosts their website.
 - Group discussed and agreed this needed careful consideration.
