1. SAG Meeting

1.1 Andy went through the earlier SAG:-

- General support for the letter to the Chancellor. It hit the right level;
- Pipeline/CSR – talked about flexing/changes/backing off but initial indications were relatively good.

1.2 CIH/UKRI presentation from Sam Stacey (*circulated to members after the meeting*) around investments and outcomes of the CIH/UKRI work.

1.2.1 There is likely to be a role for the CLC next year pushing these platforms to bring them to life and promulgate them industry wide.

1.3 Building Safety Workstream - first challenge panel was held the day before. Started to shape the guiding principles of what the challenge panel should do. Hoping to have next steps agreed at the next panel meeting, which will be shared with the SAG and SCG. Suggested that maybe some on the SAG might have a role on the challenge panel.

1.4 Frequency of meetings – every two months or three months was suggested, generally agreed two monthly meetings was the better option, with each meeting focussing on one of the four main issues suggested – Playbook, TalentView, Construct Zero and Building Safety, a possible fifth issue suggested for next year was around the CE/CA work.
